# The 1st GEOMETRICA Collection

The 1st GEOMETRICA COLLECTION is the initial collection we have entered the market with during the year 2003 and it is composed of 10 border patterns.

Each of the 10 patterns are available within a few wood specie combinations. These combinations are not exhaustive. The customer can demand changes or substitutions to fit the desired project. These hardwood floor border inlays (or parquet borders) can be independently installed with hardwood flooring or parquet flooring. *Herringbone, Basketweave, Chevrons, English* well known parquet flooring layouts or parquet panels with different designs can be complemented with borders.

The *role of the border* is to *separate two different arrangements* within the same floor unit. The standard manufacturing thickness is 10 mm but other thicknesses can also manufactured. The borders are delivered square-edge unfinished.



# Craftsmanship

Every product we manufacture, is created with the aim of enhancing the wood floor it complements. *In aesthetic and in value*.

To achieve this goal, the wood components part of each border or medallion, travel through a number of processing stages, where they are carefully transformed to fit in the final pattern.

Once ready, each piece of wood takes its place in the larger assembly a parquet decoration is composed of. All this being hand done by an artisan.

# Made to order

All of the decorative parquetry produced by us is made—to—order *nothing being* available "on stock".

Purchasing a product this type which complements a house's parquetry and last for 100 years and go through a few restorations during its life deserves waiting additional days for manufacturing.

The manufacturing time depends on the complexity of the pattern and of course on the size of the order.










**CHAIN** - images above with the Chain border installed with a parquet flooring Herringbone layout.

















# THE WOOD SPECIES



### **SYCAMORE**

### Acer Pseudoplatanus

Other Names: Great Maple, Scottish Maple,
Distribution: central and Eastern Europe to southwestern Asia
General Characteristics: A wood with a white color and a silky lustre.
Durability: Weak\* - (\*-makes reference to wood durability when exposed to
rooting in wet environments)



### SAPELE/SAPELLI

### Entandrophragma Cylindricum

Other names: Aboudikro, Libuyu, Muyovu, Sapelli, Penkwa, Sapelli Distribution: Central, West East Africa rain forests, Nigeria, Cameroon, Ivory Coast, Ghana, Zaire, Uganda and Tanzania.

General Characteristics: The heartwood is pink when freshly cut, but it matures to a medium to dark red-brown. Fine grain and moderately interlocked or wavy. The texture is fine and the luster is high and golden.

Durability: Sapele is durable with a moderate dimensional stability.
Uses: Fflooring, furniture, turnery, paneling, decorative plywood, cabinets.



## OAK (European)

### Quercus Robur

Used Names: European Oak, English Brown Oak, Rovere, Quercia, Chene,

Eicke, Eik;

Distribution: Europe, parts of West Asia, and Northern Africa. European Oak has also been imported to parts of the US and Canada.

Durability: The heartwood is naturally resistant to decay however logs and green wood may be susceptible to several boring beetle species.

Stability: Seasoned wood have moderate movement during usage.



## JATOBA (Brazilian Cherry)

### Hymenaea courbaril - Courbaril

Other Common Names: Cuapinol, Guapinol (Mexico), Guapinol (Central America), Locust, Kawanari (Guyana), Rode lokus (Surinam), Algarrobo (Spanish America), Jatahy, Jatoba (Brazil).

Distribution: Southern Mexico, throughout Central America and the West Indies to northern Brazil. Bolivia and Peru.

Durability: very resistant to brown-rot and white-rot fungi; the wood is rated as very durable. Heartwood is also rated very resistant to dry-wood termites.

Uses: Tool handles, steam-bent parts, flooring, turnery, furniture and cabinet work, railroad crossties tree-nails, gear cogs, wheel rims, and other specialty items.



### AMAZAKOUE/OVENGKOL

### Guibourtia ehie - Ovangkol - Amazakoue

Other Common Names: Ehie, Anokye (Ghana), Amazoue, Amazakoue (Ivory Coast). Currently being marketed in the United States as "Mozambique." Distribution: Ivory Coast, Ghana, Southern Nigeria, and Gabon. Prefers closed rain forests and transitional forests, often in small groups.

Durability: Heartwood moderately durable, rarely attacked by termites. Uses: Fine furniture and cabinetwork, turnery, decorative veneers, flooring. A walnutilike wood.



### AMERICAN BLACK WALNUT

#### Jualans Niar

Distribution: Eastern United States: from southern Minnesota east to Pennsylvania, New Jersey, New York; south to South Carolina, Georgia, Kansas, Nebraska, South Dakota, Florida, Alabama; west to Texas; north through Oklahoma

Durability: The walnut is very resistant to heartwood decay being one of the most durable woods.

Uses: Furniture, cabinets, gunstocks, interior paneling, veneers, parquetry, flooring



# WENGE

Other Common Names: Millettia laurentii: Wenge (Zaire), Awong (Cameroon). Millettia stuhlmannii: Panga Panga, Mpande (Tanzania).

Distribution: Southern regions of Tanzania and Mozambique, found in open forests. Wenge occurs in the Congo region in periodically inundated swampy forests.

Durability: Heartwood is rated as very durable and resistant to termite attack. Uses: Parquet or strip flooring, joinery, general construction, specialty items. Wenge is used as a hickory substitute in sporting goods, also for decorative veneer.
